INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

Instructions -

- **AUTHOR NAMES, DEGREES AND AFFILIATIONS WILL BE PRINTED IN THE PROGRAM/JOURNAL AS PROVIDED. Be sure to provide complete and accurate information for all authors.**
- Abstracts should be informative, containing four sections: (a) Introduction including a statement of the study's specific objective(s); (b) Methods including experimental approach and key methods utilized in the study; (c) Results including a summary of results and statistical analysis; and (d) Conclusions. It is NOT acceptable to state, "The results will be discussed". Please see examples of Basic Science and Clinical Studies abstracts at <http://shocksociety.org/Meetings/Abstract-Submissions/Sample-Abstracts.aspx>
- The title should be as brief as possible but should be long enough to indicate clearly the nature of the study. The title should be in all CAPs.
- Abstracts are subject to approval by the Program Committee. An abstract may be rejected for publication either because it is uninformative or because of errors, such as incorrect abbreviations, misspelled words, or failure to follow the instructions for typing. Abstracts unsuitable for direct reproduction may not be accepted.
- An individual can be named as first author on more than one abstract. However, an individual may be the first author on only one abstract accepted for oral presentation. Abstracts from the same first author not accepted for oral presentation will be eligible for poster presentation.
- In the space marked "presentation type" you will choose between three types. **1) oral or poster 2) poster only 3) oral only.**
- Indicate in the space marked topic category on the abstract form in the session in which you wish the paper presented.

Abstract Handling Fee - A non-refundable abstract handling fee of \$30 is required for each abstract submitted.

Acceptance - All abstracts will be reviewed by the Program Committee. Authors will receive notification of acceptance and presentation data prior to receipt of the program. At that time, authors of accepted abstracts are encouraged to submit a manuscript for publication in the journal, *Shock*.

Publication - All abstracts accepted for presentation will be printed in the journal, *Shock*. All authors are highly encouraged to submit a manuscript for consideration for publication in *Shock*. Please submit articles based on original work not previously published and prepare manuscripts according to the instructions published in *Shock*.
